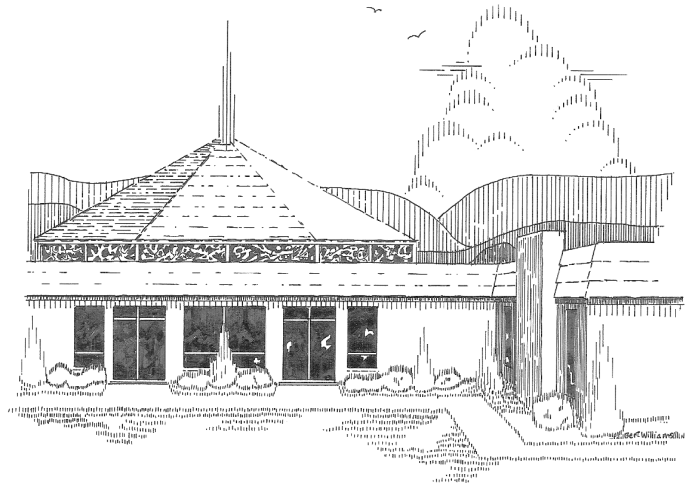
Pastor's Note
